- Do <u>NOT</u> enter or leave the seating area during a performance. Wait until between bands before moving. Do <u>NOT</u> talk during performances. Do <u>NOT</u> criticize other bands. Comments should always be positive. Adults should serve as positive role models in the stands. Courtesy is expected during all band performances. Rudeness and distracting noise will not be tolerated and can result in ejection from the stands and penalties assessed to the respective band.

#### **CONTEST INFORMATION**

- There will be eight judges music judge (1 on field and 1 in press box), visual judge (1 on field and 1 in press box), overall effect judge (2 in the box), Percussion, and Guard. The following awards will be given, Participation, best hornline, color guard and drumline, top three in each class, and I/II/III champion.
- Classes are determined by contest chairman.
